Missoula Long Range Transportation Plan Summit #2 Set for May 24

Since last November's launch of "Activate Missoula," the update to Missoula's Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP), the Missoula Metropolitan Planning Organization has been working with project consultants to review more than 700 public comments received from citizens since the project kick-off in November, as well as review plan goals and objectives.

From there, the project team is beginning to work on identifying future priorities for projects and funding for all modes of transportation, including walking, bicycling, transit, and driving. Because the LRTP will set the direction and strategies that will shape our region's transportation network for the next 30 years, the project team continues to ask the community to participate with comments.
