## Miller Creek Neighborhood Council Leadership Team Meeting Minutes

February 20, 2024; 6pm

Fire Station #5

Meeting called to order by Jack Walton. Minutes were approved from prior meeting.

Lee Boman led a discussion about the Invermere Park, with maps, lists of goals, agreements, and time lines. Lee has been involved with this Park in his neighborhood for the past 5 years. The park was to have been completed in 2022, but is still waiting for final stage of development. There have been 2 annual meetings & 12 walk-throughs that the Developer has not attended. Henbane, a poisonous plant, has been growing in the park that the Developer is supposed to get removed. Also, the Developer was asked to remove ice and snow for safety but the residents observed there's no Developer involvement. The HOA & Developer are not communicating about this matter. The goal is for them to operate as partners in finishing & caring for (maintenance) this park. It was discussed at length & decided that this matter should be brought up at City Council Forum.

Melissa Glueckert reported that it's time to plan Neighborhood Cleanup. There's a Neighborhood Action Plan coming out soon. City Council will have 2-3 neighborhoods report at City meetings & engage with the City. There will be another Leadership Training for local government, in a couple months, so watch for an email for details.

Discussion about traffic signals at Hwy 93 & Miller Creek road: The problem of no Left turn signal should be addressed by the Dept of Transportation. Holly Haslam will report her findings to her research, at the next meeting.

Alex Fregerio reported on an upcoming Fire Dept levy which would add \$7/ \$100k per household. The levy would allow 20 new hires, a Fire Inspector, building upgrades, as Missoula needs an additional Fire Station on the North side of Missoula.

Funding for Cleanup: we have \$990 left in our budget, with new funds coming in before our General Meeting in August.
