



# WEEKLY ROAD REPORT

The following is the Weekly Road Report for the week June 10, 2018

## Street and/or Lane Closures

- 1. Van Buren Street – Interstate 90 Interchange:** Beginning Monday April 16<sup>th</sup> and extending through September there will be work occurring on Van Buren Street and the interchange ramps of Interstate 90. Traffic lanes will remain open but expect slower speeds. **Westbound off-ramp will be closed starting Monday June 11<sup>th</sup> thru approximately June 25<sup>th</sup>. Use Exit 104 Orange Street/City Center.**
- 2. Russell Street – Broadway Avenue to Dakota Street:** Utility work is occurring on and around Russell Street as part of the bridge and road rebuild project. Expect closed sidewalks and shoulders and occasional lane shifts. No lane closures are proposed at this time. Expect detours and delays along Russell Street and adjoining streets.
- 3. Dakota Street – Russell Street to Inez Street:** Dakota Street at Russell Street will be closed until further notice. Access for residents will be via California Street.
- 4. South 4<sup>th</sup> Street West – Orange Street to Myrtle Street:** South 4<sup>th</sup> Street West will be closed between Orange Street and Myrtle Street for water main replacement.
- 5. South Avenue – Clark Street to Reserve Street:** The South Street west entrance to Rosauers Food and Drug will be closed may 31<sup>st</sup> through June 8<sup>th</sup>. A turn lane will be created for left turns into Rosauers east entrance (adjacent to the Eagle Lodge).
- 6. River Road – Russell Street to Mobile City Trailer Park Road:** River Road will be closed to traffic between Russell Street and Mobile City Trailer Park Road from **May 29<sup>th</sup> thru June.** Access will be via Curtis Street and Wyoming Street.
- 7. South Avenue – At Montana Rail Link crossing:** Sidewalk and parking lane closures on South Avenue near Johnson Street at the railroad crossing as part of the Bitterroot Trail expansion.
- 8. Orange Street – South 1<sup>st</sup> Street to South 6<sup>th</sup> Street West:** Work has begun on corner ramps between South 1<sup>st</sup> Street West and South 6<sup>th</sup> Street West, on the west side (southbound) Expect outside lane closures (single lane traffic) on southbound Orange Street and side street closures
- 9. Connell Avenue – South Higgins Avenue to Gerald Avenue:** Full closure of Connell Avenue between South Higgins Avenue to Gerald Avenue extending through August 2018 for construction of the new Hellgate High School addition. Detour on Daly Avenue and Gerald Avenue.

- 10. Wyoming Street – Russell Street to Inez Street:** Wyoming Street will be closed between Russell Street and Inez Street. Local traffic will be able to access businesses from the east side of Wyoming Street at Inez Street
- 11. Van Buren Street – Missoula Avenue to Lilac Street:** Sidewalk work will begin on Monday May 21<sup>st</sup>. Two way traffic will be maintained but there will be no separate bike lane. Work is expected to last thru August.
- 12. East Front Street – Jefferson Street to Madison Street:** East Front Street will be closed to thru traffic. There will be no streetside parking between Jefferson Street and Parsons Drive on the southside of Front Street.
- 13. North Pattee Street – Front Street to Main Street:** Southbound lane of Pattee Street will be closed intermittently due to construction of the new Mercantile building. Lane closures should be limited to just a few hours at a time.
- 14. North Pattee Street – Main Street to Broadway Street:** Northbound lane of Pattee Street is closed from Main Street to the alley.
- 15. East Main Street – Washington Street to Pattee Street:** Westbound lane of Main Street, north lane, will be closed from mid-block to Pattee Street. One lane of Main Street will remain open at all times. Pedestrian access on the north side of Main Street is open.
- 16. Kiwanis Street and Clay Street:** May be reduced to one lane for construction of the new student housing project.
- 17. East Front Street - Clay Street to Adams Street:** Front Street will be reduced to one lane for construction of the new Student Housing Project at the corner of Clay and East Front. This project also includes the closure of all adjacent sidewalks and possible delays of traffic for heavy truck traffic on Clay and Kiwanis Streets.
- 18. East Front Street – Higgins Avenue to Pattee Street:** Front Street will be reduced to one lane and sidewalks will be closed for deconstruction activities at the Old Mercantile Building. This work should take approximately 2 years.
- 19. Slant Street Area – Mount Avenue-Stephens Avenue:** Expect intermittent road closures for paving for the Slant Street area north of Mount Avenue and west of Stephens Avenue.
- 20. Gerald Avenue – South 6<sup>th</sup> Street East to Connell Avenue :** Water and sewer main replacement will begin Monday June 11<sup>th</sup> with full road closure of Gerald Avenue.
- 21. Grant Street – South 14<sup>th</sup> Street West to South 11<sup>th</sup> Street West:** Sidewalk improvements begin June 4<sup>th</sup>. Grant Creek will be closed between S 14<sup>th</sup> Street West and South 11<sup>th</sup> Street West and side street closures at intersections with Grant Street. This project will last through June.
- 22. South Avenue – 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Suzanne Court:** Full closure of South Avenue beginning Monday June 11<sup>th</sup> through June 20<sup>th</sup> (tentative) for sewer main installation. Detour will be 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Central Avenue to 31<sup>st</sup> Street.

Emergency access to Community Medical Center's Emergency Room will be provided.

### **Park & Trail Closures**

**23. Milwaukee Trail – S. Catlin Street to Prince Street:** Beginning Friday, April 13<sup>th</sup>, detour at S. Catlin Street via Milwaukee Way and across Russell Street to Prince Street. Detour will continue while the Russell Street underpass is being built, anticipated completion date in August. Bus stops have been moved north and south to Wyoming and South 1<sup>st</sup> Street West.

**24. Fill The Boot – England Boulevard at Reserve Street, Pine Street at Pattee Street & 39<sup>th</sup> Street at Hillview Way:** On Saturday, June 16<sup>th</sup> the Missoula Fire Department will hold their Fill-the-Boot campaign between 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM.
