



Surface Soils

Aeration Zone and Water Table:
About 40 feet below the Clark Fork River, this is the layer where air and water pressures equalize

Sole Source Aquifer: In some places is about 150 feet deep. Water flows about 3 to 5 feet per day through rocks, gravel and sand

Tertiary Sediment: Layer of clay containing water that cannot be extracted for use

BEDROCK: The same material as Missoula's surrounding mountains
