1. How will request assist in achieving Department Goal and benefit the customer?

Neighborhood Improvement Grants support resident-initiated projects that improve our neighborhoods and the City as a whole. These projects facilitate civic cooperation, neighbor engagement, and community building while making significant real physical improvements to benefit Missoulians. The most impactful and inclusive way we can support vibrant neighborhoods that reflect the needs and values of residents and enhance quality of life within our communities is to empower residents through neighborhood grants. This empowerment helps our communities reflect the values and visions, policies and plans, we hold for Missoula and our distinct neighborhoods. When residents can help determine the improvement priorities for their neighborhood, place those priorities inside the framework of adopted city plans, and then engage in solution-making, the City is fostering strong, connected communities. The Neighborhood Improvement Grants Program supports operating principles that are a direct result of community engagement and inclusion. This program is designed to promote equity, inclusions, and engagement within Neighborhoods. Following the Neighborhoods Assessment recommendations (endorsed by Forum and City Council) we are actively focusing on creating greater inclusivity and diverse representation of all Missoula residents from rewriting bylaws and operations guides to reworking our grants program to be more accessible and applications to be scored with equity in mind. The City's Strategic Plan reinforces the need to engage neighborhoods to identify and understand needs. Increasing the Neighborhood Improvement Grant program will help to support a thriving community in which we live, work, and play. The ability to sufficiently fund projects that enrich our neighborhoods, builds positive civic connections, and empowers residents to help address the needs and values of Missoula is fundamental to the Mission of our City.

2. What specifically is needed to achieve this goal?

Each year our Neighborhood Grants program is highly competitive for small fund amounts that rarely fully fund a project. An increase in annual grant funds would yield greater citizen participation and would allow an increase in impact both in the number of projects funded and in the scale of project to undertaken. The increase in funds for Neighborhood Grants is in alignment with other neighborhood program improvements that help to educate, energize and empower residents.
