Summary Description and rationale of project and funding sources:

In 2020, the City removed the Rattlesnake Dam and restored the floodplain. Phase 1 of this project includes completing the recreation plan for the site and complying with State and Federal historic preservation requirements. Phase 2 includes developing 2-mi. of new trail, and a new trailhead with a paved parking area at the end of Duncan Drive. It also includes design, engineering and construction of 3 interpretive kiosks and associated benches out of salvaged historic materials from the dam.

History & Current Status: Impact if Cancelled or Delayed

If trails to and around the restored Rattlesnake dam site are built without supplying a proper trailhead, damage to natural & built environments and impacts to the neighbors will increase. If historic materials & educational panels aren't reused on site the City will be out of compliance with State and Federal permits and this may jeopardize ability to receive future Federal & State grant funding for City Projects. In FY23 we will implement the remaining tasks in Phase 2, including construction of the trailhead and 1-mile universal trail at the end of Duncan Drive, design and installation of interpretive kiosks at three locations, and continued site restoration.
