# Missoula Invest Health Timeline



### 2016: National Launch

**May 2016** - Missoula selected as one of 50 mid-sized cities for Invest Health, receiving \$60,000 grant to focus on asthma, obesity and mental health in its lowest-income neighborhoods: **Northside/ Westside, River Road, and Franklin to the Fort**



### 2018–2019: Field Building Phase

**Nov 2018** - Launch of Field Building initiative to advance equity through the built environment

**May 2019** - Missoula leaders attended co-design retreat in Philadelphia

**July 2019** - Selected as 1 of 10 cities for 12-month technical support cohort

**Oct 2019** - Convening in Baltimore, MD to address engagement and displacement

**May 2020** - Missoula hosted a Field Building Convening for reflection and systems change



### 2020: Policy + Engagement Focus

**Sept 2020** Conducted Displacement Risk Ratio Analysis

**Oct 2020** Hosted Virtual ADU Convening with expert Kol Peterson covering equity, policy, and homeowner access to capital



### 2021: Local Collaboration

**Fall 2021** Partnered with Missoula City-County Health Department and University of Montana



### 2022: National Collaboration

**March 2022** Awarded \$33,000 Collaboration to assess DEI work

**January 2022** Worked with Savannah, Napa, and Stamford to learn from King County and Bellevue's programs
